SUBJECT: Late and Erroneous Filing Penalty (LEFP) Framework: 2004 Update of Administrative Procedures

OSFI has recently completed a review and update of the **Instruction Guide:**Administrative Procedures for the Late and Erroneous Filing Penalty (LEFP)
Framework for 2005. The updated Guide is available on our website at http://www.osfi-bsif.gc.ca/. As in prior years, all returns and filings subject to the LEFP Framework are identified in the Guide. Reference should be made to specific filing instructions for more detailed information about individual returns and filings.

The following are the principal changes made to the Guide for 2005:

- 1. Penalties will no longer be applied to the late filing of the "package": *Annual Financial Statement, Auditors' Report, and other material to go to Shareholders*. Note however that this "package" is still required to be sent by Canadian institutions to OSFI within statutory time limits.
- 2. Notices of Annual or Special Meeting of Shareholders, Proxy Circular/Dissidents' Proxy Circulars, and Forms of Proxy must now be <u>filed with OSFI</u> no later than 15 days before the annual meeting of shareholders. The previous requirement was to <u>send</u> this material to OSFI at least 21 days prior to the meeting. The change has been made to conform the deadline to other corporate filings, and to simplify OSFI's administrative processes.
- 3. The Appendix to the Guide reflects changes made in returns and filings during 2004.
