DESIGNED BY GOVERNMENT FOR GOVERNMENT

CDFS is a comprehensive financial management and reporting system designed to simplify and streamline financial administration. It was developed by a team of government financial specialists jointly with a private sector consortium of systems and accounting experts – *specifically* for government use. Cross-functional and fully capable of interfacing with your internal business systems as well as Public Works and Government Services Canada’s (PWGSC) Receiver General suite of systems, CDFS is a key public sector management resource.

This sophisticated system meets the accounting and reporting requirements of the *Financial Administration Act* and Central Agencies:

- providing automated interfaces with Receiver General systems including the Standard Payment System (SPS) and the Compensation System;
- offering automated reconciliation to the Receiver General – General Ledger (RG/GL) and Payroll System – General Ledger (PS/GL); and
- meeting accounting and reporting requirements of the Receiver General, Treasury Board, Statistics Canada and the Auditor General.

COMMON INTEGRATED FUNCTIONALITY

The design of the web-enabled CDFS is both intuitive and user-friendly. All business processes follow a logical path. All clients use the same version of the software, which is upgraded twice a year. Active monitoring of government-wide initiatives ensures that CDFS meets evolving user needs.

CDFS offers six integrated modules:

SYSTEM MANAGEMENT

is the module that lets you govern the way your CDFS operates, taking into account your unique financial coding and financial control structures, your security requirements and a host of other options.

ACCESS AND REPORTING

offers, through a data warehouse, a variety of standard reports and enquiries and the capability to download your information to create customized reports.

EXPENDITURE MANAGEMENT

lets you manage your appropriations and revolving funds, exercise commitment control, establish accruals, process accounts payable, advances and claims and schedule payments.

REVENUE MANAGEMENT

lets you manage your accounts receivable from government and non-government customers, generate statements of account, issue invoices and credit notes, post receipts and deposits, and automatically reconcile to the Government Banking System.

GENERAL ACCOUNTING

is the core of your financial system. The general ledger capabilities of CDFS – including double entry accrual accounting – allow you to generate your monthly CFMRS trial balance.

BUDGET & FORECASTING

allows you to input time-phased budget data as well as forecast information.

- Customized department defined coding blocks and Chart of Accounts that map to the Government-wide Chart of Accounts
- Allotment control on both a cash balance and a free balance basis that can be linked to budgets
- A database that lets you process multiple fiscal years concurrently without exiting the system
