



## Vacancies for the Greater Vancouver Regional District Advisory Planning Commission

The Greater Vancouver Regional District has six vacancies on its Advisory Planning Commission. The Advisory Planning Commission, a panel of volunteer citizens, was established to advise the GVRD Board, and/or the Electoral Area Director, on matters referred to it by the GVRD Board and the Director respecting the preparation and adoption of a community plan, rural land use bylaw, or a proposed bylaw or permit that may be enacted or issued under Part 26 of the *Local Government Act* for those areas within Electoral Area A.

All appointed members shall be residents of, or owners of property within the portion of Electoral Area A as shown on the attached map. There shall be one member appointed from each of the following communities or sub-areas with Electoral Area A:

1. Montizambert Wynd
2. Strachan Point
3. Ocean Point
4. Upper Indian Arm
5. Pitt Lake (west side)
6. Barnston Island

**Term of Appointment:** Each appointed member shall sit on the Advisory Planning Commission for a term of two years.

**Frequency of Meetings:** The Advisory Planning Commission meets at the call of the Director and/or the Administrator/Planner for Electoral Area A. On average there are about six meetings a year. All meetings are held at the GVRD Head Office at 4330 Kingsway, Burnaby after normal work hours.
