These paragraphs contain important information regarding the use of your personal data. Read them carefully before entering your data.

#### Register for eServices

All information that you enter into the NSERC on-line system will be saved for future logons and will be protected in accordance with federal laws and policies. It will be password protected and accessible only to you. Your data will be transmitted to NSERC in an encrypted file format and stored in a database on a secure server in the Council's offices.

Your data will not be used or disclosed for any other purpose.

Your name, password and account name (user id) will be kept on file indefinitely provided that you use the NSERC on-line system. Should you discontinue use of this system, your information (data) will remain valid for six years from the time of your last update and you will be able to re-enter the facility and access the required eServices. Once this six-year period has elapsed, your name, password and account name (user id) will be deleted from the electronic form facility.
