 provide all of the requested information so that we can process your application. If your application indicates you may benefit under section 216.1, we will
 authorize your Canadian payer(s) to reduce the amount of non-resident tax they withhold from your acting income.
- If you elect to file a return, you must report all the income you earned in Canada during the current tax year on that return, including income listed in section 6 below.
- The reduction in the amount of tax withheld does not apply to non-acting income, such as income from producing or directing. You must also report this income on your tax return, but it may be eligible for an exemption under a tax treaty between Canada and the country where you live.
