



**WORKSHEET FOR THE 2006 NORTHWEST TERRITORIES  
PERSONAL TAX CREDITS RETURN**

TD1NT-WS

Complete this worksheet if you want to calculate partial claims for your Form TD1NT, *2006 Northwest Territories Personal Tax Credits Return*, for the following:

- Age amount
- Caregiver amount
- Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older

Do not give your completed worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

**Line 2 of your TD1NT form – Age amount**

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2006, and your estimated net income from all sources for the year will be between \$30,270 and \$68,957, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Maximum age amount	5,803	1
Your estimated net income for the year		2
Base amount	– 30,270	3
Line 2 minus line 3	=	4
Multiply the amount on line 4 by 15%	× 15% =	→ – 5
Line 1 minus line 5. Enter this amount on line 2 of your TD1NT form.	=	=

**Line 8 of your TD1NT form – Caregiver amount**

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$13,430 and \$17,363, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Base amount	17,363	1
Your dependant's estimated net income for the year	–	2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$3,933)	=	3
Minus: the amount claimed on line 7 of your TD1NT form for this dependant	–	4
Line 3 minus line 4. Enter this amount on line 8 of your TD1NT form.	=	=

**Line 9 of your TD1NT form – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older**

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of your TD1NT form.

If your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$5,580 and \$9,513, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Base amount	9,513	1
Your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year	–	2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$3,933)	=	3
Minus: the amount claimed on line 7 of your TD1NT form for this dependant	–	4
Line 3 minus line 4. Enter this amount on line 9 of your TD1NT form.	=	=
