## **FUNDING TO MANITOBA, 1998-99**

---

- In 1998-99, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth \$5.6 million to the arts in Manitoba.
- In addition, over \$165,000 in payments was provided to 337 Manitoba authors through the Public Lending Right Program<sup>1</sup>. This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Manitoba to \$5.7 million.
- The Council awarded \$490,774 in grants to 66 Manitoba artists and \$5.1 million to 75 Manitoba arts organizations.
- Grants were provided in every artistic discipline - dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, writing and publishing and interdisciplinary art. The largest amount of funding (\$1.3 million) went to dance, followed by music (\$1.2 million) and theatre (\$1.1 million).
- \$5.4 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Winnipeg, making up almost (97%) of the funding going to the province. In total, all other communities in Manitoba received \$186,000 (about 3% of the total).
- 26 Manitoba artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 1997-98, making up 4.3% of all peer assessors.
- Manitoba artists and arts organizations received 5.4% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up approximately 3.3 % of cultural workers and 3.9% of the population of Canada.
- According to the 1996 Census, there are 15,700 culture workers in Manitoba including 3,800 artists.

## AIDE ACCORDÉE AU MANITOBA, 1998-1999

---

- En 1998-1999, le Conseil des Arts du Canada a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de 5,6 millions de dollars aux arts du Manitoba.
- Par ailleurs, il a fait des paiements d'une valeur totale de plus de 165 000 \$ à 337 auteurs du Manitoba dans le cadre du Programme du droit de prêt public.<sup>2</sup> Ces paiements portent à 5,7 millions de dollars le montant total des fonds que le Manitoba a reçus du Conseil des Arts du Canada.
- Le Conseil a accordé des subventions d'une valeur totale de 490 774 \$ à 66 artistes du Manitoba et de 5,1 millions de dollars à 75 organismes artistiques du Manitoba.
- Le Conseil a attribué des subventions dans toutes les disciplines artistiques - danse, musique, théâtre, arts visuels, arts médiatiques, lettres et édition et art interdisciplinaire. Le montant le plus élevé (1,3 million) a été attribué à la danse, suivie de la musique (1,2 million) et du théâtre (1,1 million).
- Le Conseil a accordé 5,4 millions aux artistes et organismes artistiques de Winnipeg, soit près de 97 p. 100 des fonds accordés à la province. En tout, toutes les autres collectivités du Manitoba ont reçu 186 000 \$ (environ 3 p. 100 du total).
- 26 artistes et professionnels des arts du Manitoba ont rempli des fonctions d'évaluateurs en 1997-1998, soit 4,3 p. 100 de tous les évaluateurs du Conseil.
- Les artistes et organismes artistiques du Manitoba ont reçu 5,4 p. 100 de l'aide du Conseil des Arts du Canada. La province représente approximativement 3,3 p. 100 des travailleurs du secteur culturel et 3,9 p. 100 de la population du Canada.
- Selon le recensement de 1996, le Manitoba compte 15 700 travailleurs du secteur culturel, dont 3 800 artistes.
