



# CATSA's Holiday List



Please **do not wrap gifts**. Their contents may need to be inspected.



All **alcoholic beverages** must be in their original container, with the commercial seal intact. Homemade wine/beer and any alcoholic beverages with an unknown alcohol content (%) will not be accepted as carry-on or checked baggage.



**Food products** should be packed in your carry-on baggage, given certain items may require additional searches of your checked baggage, which can cause delays.



Leave **ammunition** at home, as well as anything that is not permitted as carry-on or checked baggage. **Toy weapons** such as toy guns must be packed in your checked baggage.

All **cameras** must be inspected by X-ray. Pack all **camera film**, used or unused, in your carry-on baggage. X-ray equipment at pre-board screening checkpoints will not damage film under 800 ASA/ISO. Digital cameras can be packed in any baggage.



**Electronic devices** may be screened by special screening equipment. Take all electronic equipment including portable computers, cellular phones and CD players out of their carrying case or your carry-on and place them in a tray.

*In order to prevent flight delays, we recommend contacting your carrier to know exactly the number and size of items permitted as carry-on. **Avoid the rush! Arrive early!***
