 Carbon is key to international climate change policy, programs, planning and economics.

The *Carbon Finance Day* has been designed by the International Emissions Trading Association to focus on many of the key issues involved in Clean Development Mechanism, Joint Implementation, carbon finance, emissions trading and pricing.

In the morning, the keynote address will be delivered by the Honourable Pierre Pettigrew, Canada's Minister of Foreign Affairs. He will be followed by Andrei Marcu, President and CEO of the International Emissions Trading Association and Odin Knudsen, Senior Manager of World Bank Carbon Finance Business. The morning will conclude with a roundtable of regulators and market participants discussing market sentiment.

The afternoon features workshops on lessons learned and experience gained, the perspective of carbon funds, journalist training, creating GHG markets in the U.S., waste management and industrial gases, finance, the EU trading scheme and pricing.

The evening wraps up with a variety of workshops.
