Parliamentary democracy. Unicameral parliament with a 120-seat Assembly (Sobranie). Prime Minister elected by the Assembly. Council of Ministers elected by the majority vote of all the deputies in the Assembly. Administrative divisions: 120 municipalities. Governing coalition: Coalition for Macedonia (ZMZ) and Democratic Union for Integration (DUI).
