#### Type of Government

Parliamentary democracy. Unicameral parliament with a 140-seat People's Assembly (Kuvendi i Republikës së Shqipërisë). Prime Minister (leader of the majority party or the majority coalition) appointed by the President. Council of Ministers nominated by the Prime Minister and approved by the President. Administrative divisions: 12 counties. Governing coalition: Socialist Party of Albania (PSSH), Democratic Alliance Party (PADS), Agrarian Party (PAS) & Union for Human Rights Party (PBDN).


