Parliamentary Democracy. Unicameral with a 150-seat National Council (Narodna Rada). Prime Minister (leader of the majority party or the majority coalition) appointed by the President. Cabinet appointed by the President under the advice of the Prime Minister. Administrative divisions: 8 regions. Governing coalition: Slovak Democratic and Christian Union Party (SKDU), the Party of the Hungarian Coalition (SMK), Christian Democratic Movement (KDH) and the New Civic Alliance Party (ANO).



Canadian exports to country




