General

Incorporated in 1905, Kelowna has a total area of 22,837.7 ha. By highway the City is 471 km east of Vancouver, 78 km north of Penticton, 47 km south of Vernon and 606 km west of Calgary. Kelowna is in the Central Okanagan Regional District.

The three industries employing the most people in this area in 1996 were Retail Trade, Health and Social Services, and Manufacturing.


