

For example, ECM users can attach a document, such as a signed contract, to a customer file. Integrating ECM into enterprise applications combines business *content* (documents) with business *context* (transactional data).

Open Text's Livelink *for SAP Solutions*, formerly known as IXOS Suite for SAP, is a suite of ECM solutions that gives organizations the ability to create, access, manage, and securely archive data and documents for SAP solutions within a single content repository.¹ The suite is hardware-platform-independent and features tight integration with SAP technologies, business applications, and workflow. So organizations can extract maximum value from their enterprise


Vendor Invoice Management —
