



CONTEST RULES

36 definitions of *la Francophonie* for our 36th anniversary!

1 - How to enter

The contest is open to employees of the Public Service of Canada, excluding the members of the organizing committee of the *Rendez-vous de la Francophonie 2006* in the Public Service.

By taking part in the contest, the winners agree to have their texts reproduced, translated and posted on the Public Service Human Resources Management Agency of Canada Web site and at the Museum of Civilization on March 10, 2006. The organizers also reserve the right to post on the OLLO site the names of the authors of the selected definitions and the name of their home department.

In 150 words or less, please define what *la Francophonie* in Canada means to you. E-mail your entry to franco36@hrma-agrh.gc.ca or send it via our Web site at http://www.hrma-agrh.gc.ca/ollo/index-sm_e.asp, under the heading *Francophonie*.

All entries must be received by no later than February 28, 2006. Entries not submitted by e-mail or via our OLLO Web site will be automatically disqualified.

Anyone using an assumed name, pseudonym or false identity to participate in the contest will be automatically disqualified.

2 - Prizes

Participants could win one of the prizes mentioned on the contest poster.

The prizes will be awarded on March 10, 2006, at the Museum of Civilization. Winners who cannot attend the launch will receive their prize by mail within a few weeks following the event (please provide us with your contact information).

3 - Selection criteria

- Originality
- Appropriateness to the theme
- Coherence of the message
- Quality of the language

The organizing committee will be responsible for selecting the 36 definitions to be posted at the Museum of Civilization and on the Web site of the *Rendez-vous de la Francophonie 2006* in the Public Service.
