SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Utilizing tools and knowledge specific to their area of training and expertise, provides assessment of the impact of the workplace environment (chemical, physical, biological) upon of the physical, mental and social well-being of the individual and groups of workers. Involving workplace parties, takes action designed to prevent the negative impact of workplace conditions. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Evaluation and consultation regarding workplace exposures and their controls for individuals and groups (may include workplace visits).
- Provides technical expertise related to hazard anticipation, recognition, evaluation and control (which may include interpretation of exposure monitoring data).
- Development of retrospective exposure profiles for individuals and groups in order to determine the relationship between workplace exposures and specific health outcomes.
- Analyses the potential link between occupational exposure and illness from an individual case to a group of workers, occupation or industry.
- Collaborates with other co-workers with complimentary expertise to provide comprehensive evaluation of workplace issues.
- Gathers and analyses relevant scientific and medical literature
- Makes recommendations regarding changes and appropriate controls.
- Preparation and presentation of material to workplace parties which may include writing reports including recommendations.
