

"The proponent is required to submit an application for authorizations to the Navigable Waters Protection Program NWPP of Transport Canada for the watercourses involved in this project. Any prescribed requirements pursuant to the Navigable Waters Protection Act as determined by the NWPP, Transport Canada, must be strictly adhered to."
