

# Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada (AAFC) Economist Development Program (ESDP)

Permanent Positions in the ES (Economist) Development Program. The program is designed to develop individuals from the ES-02 entry level to ES-04 working level, in order to prepare them for senior positions at AAFC. Employees will gain practical experience and develop their skills through varied work assignments and learning and development opportunities.

**LOCATIONS:** Various - Across Canada

\*positions are primarily at the entry level, which is the ES-02 group and level (however all qualifications are the same for the ES-02, ES-03 and ES-04 group and levels but are differentiated by breadth and depth of the qualification - should a candidate clearly demonstrate wider breadth and depth in the qualifications they would be considered for a higher level position).

# **REQUIREMENTS**

#### **EDUCATION:**

People who have graduated (or who will have graduated by Summer 2005) with a degree from a recognized university with acceptable specialization\* in economics, sociology, or statistics.

#### \*Note:

Candidates must always have a university degree. The courses for the specialization do not necessarily have to be part of a degree program in the required specialization. The specialization may also be obtained through an acceptable combination of education, training and/or experience. AAFC has established the minimum course requirement is the equivalent of five full year courses in economics, sociology or statistics or a combination of five full year or ten half year courses in the three disciplines.
