



Commercial Transportation Energy Efficiency Rebate Application Form

(Issue date: July 15, 2005)

Background

As part of the Government of Canada's commitment to improve energy efficiency and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions that contribute to climate change, funds have been allocated to pay a rebate for the installation of pre-qualified equipment that provides truck-cab or bus-interior heating and/or cooling.

The rebate is a joint effort between the Government of Canada and the equipment manufacturers to encourage vehicle operators to reduce unnecessary engine idling. The reduction of engine idling will reduce fuel use and GHG emissions as well as reduce engine wear. To ensure that a reasonable amount of GHG emissions are eliminated for the expenditure of public money, the rebate is limited to eligible Class 6, 7 and 8 diesel-powered trucks and buses licensed for commercial on-road service in Canada.

Application Process

Applicants should obtain and read our **Consumer Notice** (available from your dealer) before submitting this form as incomplete applications will be rejected. To apply, fully complete and sign this form (including the questionnaire) and give it to your dealer with a copy of the required sales documentation. If you complete the form at home, please return it to any Canadian dealer who sells your equipment or mail it (with the required documentation) to the equipment manufacturer directly (addresses in the Consumer Notice). **Do not send this form to Natural Resources Canada.**

The equipment manufacturer will verify the application and then apply to Natural Resources Canada for the rebate funds. The manufacturer will then mail the rebate cheque directly to you. **Only one rebate will be paid per vehicle.**

EXTENDED WARRANTY INCENTIVE

The manufacturer of your equipment will offer an extended warranty of not less than 6 months to those who voluntarily supply the hours-of-use data from their new equipment. You will be offered this incentive in a letter from Natural Resources Canada (after approximately 12 months of use) who will ask you to supply the data on a postage paid return card. The data can also be downloaded free of charge by your equipment dealer. Natural Resources Canada will use the data to assess the effectiveness of the equipment in reducing GHG emissions. The warranty extension will begin on the last day of the standard warranty.
