The description of controlled goods should provide sufficient detail so as to disclose the goods true identity void the use of trade names, generic names or general terms that do not adequately describe the goods.

All controlled goods should be listed in numerical order as indicated in the Export Control List.

#### Section D

It is the Designated Official's responsibility to ensure that the temporary worker meets the definition of a "temporary worker" for the purpose of the Controlled Goods Program (CGP). A "temporary worker" means an officer, director or employee of a person registered under the Controlled Goods Regulations and who is not a Canadian citizen ordinarily resident in Canada or a permanent resident ordinarily resident in Canada.
