Section A and Section B

Complete as requested.

Section C

The description of controlled goods should provide sufficient detail so as to disclose the goods true identity and avoid the use of trade names, generic names or general terms that do not adequately describe the goods.

All controlled goods should be itemized in numerical order as indicated in the Export Control List.

Section D

The purpose of the visit must clearly indicate specific information related to a program, project or contract for which the visitor may be required to examine possess or transfer controlled goods. Please indicate the expected duration of the visit.

Section E

It is the Designated Officials responsibility to ensure that the visitor meets the definition of a "visitor" for the purpose of the Controlled Goods Program (CGP). A "visitor" means an individual who is not an officer, director or employee of a person registered under the Controlled Goods Regulations and who is not a Canadian citizen ordinarily resident in Canada or a permanent resident ordinarily resident in Canada.
