Paying the fees

Consult the Instruction guide or the Fees section of our Web site or the *Guide for Federal Skilled Workers* or the *Guide for Business Class* applicants to calculate your fees. You must use a bank draft and pay the full immigration processing fees, in Canadian dollars. Because exchange rates vary, fees must be paid by bank draft, in Canadian dollars, drawn on a bank in Canada, and which will clear there. Make the draft payable to “The Receiver General for Canada”. Write your name and address on the back. Make sure that you have sent the correct type of bank draft; otherwise, your application will be returned to you. **Do not enclose cash.**
