# Appendix A - Berlin

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### Paying the fees

Consult the Instruction guide or the Fees section of our Web site to calculate your fees.

Fees may be paid:

#### **A. In Canadian Dollars:**

By bank draft or certified cheque in Canadian dollars drawn on a bank in Canada which will clear there. This draft, which must be made payable to The Receiver General for Canada, can be purchased at most banks.

#### **B. In Euros:**

By transfer (Überweisung) or cash deposit (Bareinzahlung) at any bank to the following account:

**Include the proof of payment** (e.g.: receipt from the bank or print-out of internet transaction) with your application. The receipt must be legible and contain the date of the transaction and the name and date of birth of the principal applicant. If you require a copy of the receipt for your records, make your own copy before mailing your application.
