CANADA-SASKATCHEWAN MUNICIPAL RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND

The Government of Canada is investing \$38 million in municipal infrastructure projects across Saskatchewan over the next four years through the Canada-Saskatchewan Municipal Rural Infrastructure Fund (C-S MRIF).

Participating communities contribute half the cost of a project. The Fund sets aside up to 20 per cent of its resources for projects in Saskatoon and Regina. It provides \$4 million for northern Saskatchewan communities. To date, about \$91 million has been announced for 91 projects. The federal government has provided more than \$12.9 million.
