Canadian-U.S. Harmonization

- Common objective: more efficient, effective registration process through use of information technology – range of tools
- Began efforts 1996
- Close collaboration on use of tools, guidance, lessons learned

On-going activities

- Encourage submission of study reports in electronic format w/Adobe PDF as standard
 - Inter-operates w/common software word processing, spreadsheet, statistical analysis – to generate PDF
 - Scan/OCR legacy paper to generate PDF
 - Inexpensive for data submitters to adopt


On-going activities - continued

- Train reviewers in use of Adobe Acrobat
 - Evaluate studies text and tables
 - Prepare review documents
 - Use w/statistical analysis, spreadsheet, word processing software
- Supports detailed evaluation of individual study reports

New Initiative – E-Index

- Tool to identify studies in submission
- Consistent with OECD Dossier harmonized guidelines
- Supports single electronic submission to multiple countries/regions
- Pilot joint review submissions in 2004 –
 Bayer, Syngenta, DowAgrosciences + PMRA and OPP

E-index



New initiative – Checklist of Administrative Information

- Guides submitters on assembly of required documents for U.S. and Canadian submission
- Identifies common and unique elements
- References required forms

- OPP announcement: encourages submission of OECD dossier formatted submissions in electronic format
- PMRA adopts OPP's technical specifications for creation of PDF
- PMRA adopts OPP's approach for claiming and segregating confidential business information

Updates - continued

- Study report binders PMRA will accept simpler style used by U.S. submitters
- DER templates harmonization
 - Full collection posted on PMRA Web site
 - OPP to post full collection in near future
- Study report templates preparation by OPP
 - Mirror DER templates to facilitate their use
 - Posting to Web as each discipline completed

Future activities

- CropLife America and OPP considering a 3rd Electronic Submission and Review Workshop in 2004 (March 2000, January 2003)
- PMRA and OPP continue to exchange ideas, approaches, lessons learned
- PMRA's forms-based, on-line application submission process- Summer 2004
