

NAFTA TWG Meeting Stakeholder Session December 4, 2003

Two areas of interest:

- 1. Agricultural products. Some grower organizations, particularly in US/Canada border regions, have expressed an interest in NAFTA labels.
- 2. Non-agricultural products. The NAWG has expressed an interest in full NAFTA product labeling US, Canada, Mexico.

The NAFTA Label will:

- Standardize label formats among NAFTA countries for new product registrations.
- Eliminate the need for developing separate labels in NAFTA countries.
- Allow for transport and use of pesticide products across borders.

The NAFTA Label will not:

- Guarantee price harmonization across borders.
- Alleviate all trade irritants.
- Be mandatory for all new product registrations.

CHALLENGES:

- NAFTA label submissions are voluntary for registrants.
- Current differences in labelling requirements, e.g., signal word cut-offs.
- Need procedures for processing amendments to NAFTA labels.

What's been done on this front?

 Registrants have been encouraged to submit NAFTA labels.

TI-435 Example:

- Bayer stepped forward with proposal for NAFTA label during TI-435 registration process.
- Countries were working through signal word discrepancies.
- However, questions arose with regard to future label amendments (e.g., adding new use) and registration approval timing.

Sporodex example:

- NAFTA label was created in 2002 for biological fungicide, Sporodex.
- However, that label is not in use by registrant due to more restrictive language required statutorily by one of the countries, and marketing issues.

What can you do?

- Growers are strongly encouraged to provide input to industry and government regarding which product labels they would like to see proposed for a NAFTA label under Joint Review.
- The registrant community is encouraged to work with NAFTA Joint Review Coordinators and propose NAFTA label submissions for review.

What can we do?

- Commit to implementing the GHS as it relates to pesticides in coordinated manner
- Continue to encourage development of NAFTA labels and commit to work through and resolve issues as they arise
- Develop and implement NAFTA label amendment process and procedures
