

Guidance on Label Requirements for PMRA Registered Product Renewal



The label requirements for product renewal are:



- 2 hard copies of your marketplace label (i.e., The label that is found on the actual container in the marketplace)
- 1 electronic file in PDF normal of the English **text** that appears on the label that was most recently approved by the PMRA
- 1 electronic file in PDF normal of the French text that appears on the label that was most recently approved by the PMRA

How to create the electronic PDF file:

Step 1) Create separate electronic files of the English and French label text using your authoring software e.g., Word, WordPerfect, etc. (Your authoring software is the software you use to create the electronic file!)

Convert the file to PDF format Step 2)

from your authoring software using Adobe Acrobat (version 4 or 5) How?

Preferred

Use the Adobe Writer from your printer selection in the print dialog box (This method provides a more accurate conversion of complex files.)

Other

- Use Adobe Distiller
- Use the PDF creation feature directly from your authoring software.

Step 3) Name your file using the naming convention below

[Registration#]-[date]-[label or component*]-[ENG/FR].pdf

*e.g., Booklet, Sleeve

7654-sept[renewalvear]-sleeve-ENG.pdf

7654-sept[renewalyear]-sleeve-FR.pdf

Electronic — Do's and Don'ts

DO

- Include symbol signal words along with the graphic symbol (this graphic is acceptable)
- Limit the use of tables
- Use Times New Roman or Courier fonts
- Contact the Pest Management Information service for additional guidance if required (1 800 267 6315 or (613) 736 3799)

DON'T

- Don't use column formatting of the label text (i.e., newspaper formatting).
- Don't include graphics such as a company logo or pictures of pests
- Don't combine English and French text in the same electronic file (even if it's only on the principal display panel, this is not acceptable)
- Don't include any security features on your file(s) or disk(s)
- Don't use proprietary fonts.
