



URMULE Update

User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion (URMULE) Registrations June 1, 1998 - June 30, 1998

The URMULE Update provides timely information on the latest proposals for minor use label expansion of pesticides that have been evaluated and accepted for registration.

A Certificate of Registration, based on a supplemental label, has been issued for the following products, thereby legalizing the use. Registrants are required to add the new use to the full product label at the next printing. Provincial authorities may incorporate such acceptable uses in publishing recommendations on the use of agricultural chemicals with the knowledge that they meet the requirements of the *Pest Control Products Act*.

Horticulture Crops and Products

Tree fruits:

Clofentezine (Apollo - AgrEvo), registration number 21035. For the control of two spotted spider mite and European red mite on peaches and nectarines.

Small fruits:

Bacillus thuringiensis (Foray 48BA - Abbott), registration number 24978. For the control of whitemarked tussock moth on blueberry.

Vegetables:

Fosetyl-al (Aliette WDG - Rhone Poulenc), registration number 24458. For the control of downy mildew on greenhouse lettuce (British Columbia only).

Abamectin (Avid - Novartis), registration number 24485. For the control of two spotted spider mite on greenhouse peppers and cucumbers.

Cyhalothrin-lambda (Matador - Zeneca), registration number 24984. For the control of onion thrips on onions and garlic.

Metribuzin (Sencor 75DF - Bayer), registration number 17242. For weed control on desi and kabuli chickpeas in Western Canada.

Ornamentals

Copper (Phyton 27 - Source Technology Biologicals), registration number 21699. For the control of black spot on outdoor roses.
