



URMULE Update

User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion (URMULE) Registrations July 1, 1998 - July 31, 1998

The URMULE Update provides timely information on the latest proposals for minor use label expansion of pesticides that have been evaluated and accepted for registration.

A Certificate of Registration, based on a supplemental label, has been issued for the following products, thereby legalizing the use. Registrants are required to add the new use to the full product label at the next printing. Provincial authorities may incorporate such acceptable uses in publishing recommendations on the use of agricultural chemicals with the knowledge that they meet the requirements of the *Pest Control Products Act*.

Horticulture Crops and Products

Small fruits:

Fluazifop-P-butyl (Fusilade II - Zeneca), registration number 21209. For grassy weed control in strawberry nursery stock (Eastern Canada only).

Propiconazole (Topas 250E - Engage), registration number 24030. For mummyberry control on highbush blueberry.

Vegetables:

Propiconazole (Topas 250E - Engage), registration number 24030. As a tank mix with Ripcord for use on corn.

Grasses Grown for Seed

Fenoxaprop-p-ethyl, MPCA and Thifensulfuron methyl (Triumph Plus - AgrEvo), registration numbers 22348 and 21645. For post-emergent weed control on slender, western and northern wheatgrass grown for seed and forage.

Ornamentals

Myclobutanil (Nova 40W - Rohm&Haas), registration number 22399. For rust control on geraniums and powdery mildew control on poinsettias.
