URMULE UPDATE

User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion (URMULE) - registrations October 1 - November 6, 1998

The **URMULE Update** provides timely information on the latest proposals for minor use label expansion of pesticides that have been evaluated and accepted for registration.

For the following pesticides, a Certificate of Registration has been issued based on a Supplemental Label, making the use legal. Registrants are required to add the new use to the full product label at the next printing. Provincial authorities, in publishing recommendations on the use of agricultural chemicals, may incorporate such acceptable uses in the knowledge that they meet the requirements of the *Pest Control Products Act*.
