This Regulatory Decision Document completes the Pest Management Regulatory Agency's (PMRA) regulatory decision-making process concerning the use of EXITTM ISP and EXITTM Concentrate Rodenticide for the control of Richardson's ground squirrels.

1.0 Introduction

This Regulatory Decision Document completes the PMRA's regulatory decision-making process concerning the use of the integrated systems product EXITTM ISP containing α -olefin sulfonate sodium and mustard seed powder and the associated end-use product EXITTM Concentrate Rodenticide for the control of Richardson's ground squirrels.

2.0 Background

The PMRA carried out an assessment of available information in accordance with the Pest Control Product Regulations. The assessment found that there was sufficient information to allow a determination of the safety, merit and value of the integrated systems product EXITTM ISP and associated end-use product EXITTM Concentrate Rodenticide, manufactured by Exit Holdings. The PMRA concluded that the use of EXITTM Concentrate Rodenticide in accordance with the label accompanying the product has merit and value consistent with the Pest Control Products Regulations and does not entail an unacceptable risk of harm.

This product was proposed for registration in Proposed Regulatory Decision Document PRDD2005-04. The PMRA received one comment in response to PRDD2005-04. The comment supported the merit and value of EXITTM Concentrate Rodenticide under the conditions of use.

3.0 Regulatory Decision

Based on the considerations outlined above, the use of the integrated systems product EXITTM ISP containing α -olefin sulfonate sodium and mustard seed powder and the associated end-use product EXITTM Concentrate Rodenticide for the control of Richardson's ground squirrels are eligible for full registration under the Pest Control Products Regulations.
