



SIGNS MUST BE POSTED AT EACH PEST CONTROL EXPERIMENTAL SITE.

Cooperator Information from the Pest Management Regulatory Agency on Posting of Research Areas



WHY?

Posting of a sign informs the public that research is being conducted under the provisions of the Pest Control Products Regulations.

HOW?

Ask your company representative to provide you with a pre-printed sign (see sample).

WHEN?

The sign must be installed immediately before the pesticide application and must remain in place until the crop has been harvested or as long as data is being collected.

WHERE?

The sign must be located at the point of entry. If there are several points of entry, then signs must be posted at the most likely points of entry.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A SITE IS NOT POSTED OR IS INCORRECTLY POSTED?

Your company representative will be contacted and will be requested to take corrective action. A follow-up inspection may occur to ensure compliance with regard to posting.

Here is a sample of what an appropriate sign should look like:
