Re-evaluation Decision Document

1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane is now complete.

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane is acceptable for continued registration provided that the proposed mitigation measures are adopted. Additional data requirements are identified.

This RRD includes the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane as published in the Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document PACR2004-29, *Re-evaluation of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane*, on 15 July 2004.

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1.0 Introduction

The re-evaluation of the available information for the active ingredient 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane and its associated uses as an additive microbiocide/microbiostat has been completed by the PMRA.

2.0 Background

The purpose of this RRD is to notify the registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane is now complete.

On 15 July 2004, the PMRA published PACR2004-29, *Re-evaluation of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane*, for consultation on the proposed regulatory decision for 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane. No comments were received by the PMRA concerning this PACR.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane.

3.0 Regulatory decision

The PMRA has determined that 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane is acceptable for continuing registration provided that the mitigation measures specified in the PACR are implemented.

Section 5.0 of the PACR outlined additional requirements for continued registration of 1,2-dibromo-2,4-dicyanobutane. The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
