

Re-evaluation Decision Document

RRD2005-05

Sodium Monofluoroacetate

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of sodium monofluoroacetate is now complete.

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that sodium monofluoroacetate is acceptable for continued registration provided that the proposed mitigation measures are adopted. Additional data requirements are identified.

This RDD includes regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of sodium monofluoroacetate as published in the Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document <u>PACR2004-20</u>, *Re-evaluation of sodium monofluoroacetate*, on 18 June 2004.

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1.0 Introduction

The re-evaluation of the available information for the active ingredient sodium monofluoroacetate and its associated uses as a predacide for wolves and coyotes has been completed by the PMRA.

2.0 Background

The purpose of this RRD is to notify the registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of sodium monofluoroacetate is now complete.

On 18 June 2004, the PMRA published PACR2004-20, *Re-evaluation of Sodium Monofluoroacetate*, for consultation on the proposed regulatory decision for sodium monofluoroacetate. No comments were received by the PMRA concerning this PACR.

3.0 Regulatory Decision

The PMRA has determined that sodium monofluoroacetate is acceptable for continuing registration provided that the mitigation measures specified in the PACR are implemented.

The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements affecting their product registrations and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
