Putrescent Whole Egg Solids

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of putrescent whole egg solids is now complete.

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that putrescent whole egg solids are acceptable for continued registration consistent with Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document [PACR2004-02](#), *Re-evaluation of Putrescent Whole Egg Solids*, published 15 March 2004, provided that the mitigation measures included in the PACR are adopted.

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1.0 Introduction

The re-evaluation of the available information for the active ingredient putrescent whole egg solids and its associated uses as an animal repellent or feeding deterrent on non-edible plants, trees and shrubs has been completed by the PMRA.

2.0 Background

The purpose of this RRD is to notify the registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that the re-evaluation of putrescent whole egg solids is now complete.

On 15 March 2004, the PMRA published PACR2004-02, *Re-evaluation of Putrescent Whole Egg Solids*, for consultation on the proposed regulatory decision for putrescent whole egg solids. No comments were received by the PMRA concerning this PACR.

This RRD presents the regulatory decisions resulting from the re-evaluation of putrescent whole egg solids.

3.0 Regulatory decision

The PMRA has determined that putrescent whole egg solids are acceptable for continuing registration provided that the mitigation measures specified in the PACR are implemented. These mitigation measures include label statements to reduce potential exposure for users allergic to egg products.

Section 5.0 of the PACR outlined additional administrative requirements for continued registration of putrescent whole egg solids. The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
