



Re-evaluation Decision Document

RRD2006-01

Polybutene

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated the active ingredient polybutene and its associated uses as a bird repellent in terrestrial non-food areas, outdoor residential areas and indoor non-food areas.

On 30 March 2004, Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration (PACR) document [PACR2004-03](#), *Re-evaluation of Polybutene*, was published for consultation. No comments were received that resulted in any changes to the regulatory decision as described in PACR2004-03.

The PMRA has determined that polybutene is acceptable for continued registration provided that the mitigation measures to further protect workers and the environment specified in PACR2004-03 are implemented. The registrants will be informed by letter of the specific requirements affecting their product registrations and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
