



# Re-evaluation Decision Document

RRD2006-09

## Barium Metaborate

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated the active ingredient barium metaborate and its associated uses as a microbiocide (material preservative) for use in paints, coatings and plastics.

On 17 June 2004, Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration document [PACR2004-18](#), *Re-evaluation of Barium Metaborate*, was published for consultation. The PMRA did not receive any comments concerning PACR2004-18.

The PMRA has determined that this active ingredient is acceptable for continued registration. Mitigation measures to further protect workers are specified in PACR2004-18. The registrants have been informed by letter of the specific requirements affecting their product registrations and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
