Re-evaluation Decision Document

RRD2006-16

Bronopol

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated the active ingredient bronopol and its associated uses as a commercial biocide and preservative.

On 24 August 2005, Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration document <u>PACR2005-06</u>, *Re-evaluation of Bronopol*, was published for consultation. The PMRA did not receive any comments concerning PACR2005-06.

The PMRA has determined that bronopol is acceptable for continued registration. Mitigation measures to further protect workers and the environment are specified in PACR. The registrants have been informed by letter of the specific requirements, including additional confirmatory data requirements as defined in the PACR, affecting their product registrations and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
