

# **Re-evaluation Decision Document**

## Di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated the active ingredient di-*n*-propyl isocinchomeronate (MGD) and its associated uses as insecticide on cattle, horses, ponies and dogs as well as a surface/space spray or fog in farm buildings.

On 6 April 2006, Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration document <u>PACR2006-04</u>, *Re-evaluation of Di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate*, was published for consultation. The PMRA did not receive any comments concerning PACR2006-04.

The PMRA has determined that this active ingredient is acceptable for continued registration. Mitigation measures to further protect workers and the environment are specified in PACR2006-04. The registrants have been informed by letter of the specific requirements affecting their product registrations and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.
