What is the Business Development Fund?

The Business Development Fund (BDF) provides contributions of up to \$150,000 to support business development in Nunavut. Contributions do not need to be repaid.

Businesses can apply for assistance up to:

\$20,000 for Planning or Other Start-Up Costs \$75,000 for Pilot or Demonstration Projects \$25,000 for Business Creation or Expansion \$15,000 per year,ttaling \$45,000 for Marketing and Product Development; \$150,000 for Venture Capital Investments \$20,000 for Business Skills Development; and \$25,000 for Business Relief.

Eligibility?

Businesses that show a greater benefit to the comunity than potential market disruption, and that replace imports or generate exports, may be considered. Generally, those projects that provide the greatest economic benefit to Nunavut are the most likely to be approved for financial assistance.

Market disruption occurs when there is a negative effect on an existing business in the community.

How Do I Apply for a Contribution?

To apply for a contribution under the BDF, contact your Hamlet s Community Economic Development, or your Department of Sustainable Development s Regional Office.

Applicants must contribute a minimum equity toward the total costs associated with the BDF application:

20% if the business is located in Iqaluit, 10% of the total for a business located in Rankin Inlet, Kugluktuk, or Cambridge Bay, 5% in all other Nunavut communities.

Equity refers to the dollar value of the money, equipment, tools or labour that is invested in the business. Contributions other than money or tangible assets

should not account for more than 50% of the total equity

contribution.

Payments will only be approved when a contribution agreement is signed, when the required equity is in place, and when your business has received the necessary approval from regulatory and licensing agencies. Your business may also be required to get support from community or regional councils.

Additional information may be required.

Will I Have To Do An Audit?

The Department of Sustainable Development will require an audit for projects funded by the BDF.
