Implementation

The new PCPA will be brought into force by an Order that will be made by the government once key regulations to support the new Act are in place. The target date is spring 2004.

A Phased Approach to Implementation

During 2003-04, the PMRA will be consulting on the content of proposed regulations:

- Discussion Document on WHMIS-equivalent provisions
- Discussion Document on adverse effects reporting
- Discussion Document on sales data reporting
- Discussion Document on reconsideration of decisions
