- To reduce reliance on pesticide use for lawn care through:
 - the application of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) principles
 - use of reduced risk products
 - * application of pesticides only when necessary

Major Elements of Healthy Lawn Strategy

- assessing types of pesticide products available to homeowners
- reviewing the classification of domestic pesticide products
- improving pesticide product labeling
- enhancing educational/training material and programs for homeowners, vendors and service providers and green space managers
