Thank you for your letter of July 24, 2001, informing me of the Commissioner of Competition's intention to withdraw the current *Principles and Guidelines for Environmental Labelling and Advertising (PGELA)* in favour of encouraging the use of the CAN/CSA-ISO 14021-00 standard. Since the latter is both a National Standard of Canada and an unmodified ISO standard, the Office of Consumer Affairs applauds this change which promotes the use of harmonized standards, thereby reducing consumer confusion.
