**THE ACCUSED** stands charged:


THAT it did, between approximately December 1999 and June 2000, the exact dates being unknown, in various locations outside Canada, unlawfully conspire, combine, agree or arrange with Dupont-Akra Polyester, LLC, currently known as DAK Fibres, LLC, Wellman, Inc., Nan Ya Plastics Corporation, America and Nan Ya Plastics Corporation, and person or persons unknown, to prevent or lessen, unduly, competition in the production, manufacture, purchase, sale, storage, transportation or supply of a product, namely, polyester staple fibre, in Canada, contrary to paragraph 45(1)(c) of the *Competition Act*.
