

INDICTMENT

THE ACCUSED stands charged:

That **LA COMPAGNIE BRASSERIE STROH (QUÉBEC) LTÉE.** between April 1999 and April 2000 inclusively, did, by agreement, threat, promise or any like means, attempt to influence upward, or to discourage the reduction of, the price at which retailers supplied or offered to supply or advertised Stroh beer and other malt-based beverage products in the Province of Québec, contrary to subsection 61(1)a) of the *Competition Act* (the "Act"), and therefore committed an offence contrary to subsection 61(9) of the Act.
