**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board has received an application for certification from the applicant union as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of 141467 Canada inc., doing business as Sylco Express Enr., pursuant to section 24.1 of the Canada Labour Code (Part I - Industrial Relations);

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has found the applicant to be a trade union within the meaning of the *Code* and has determined the unit described hereunder to be appropriate for collective bargaining and is satisfied that a majority of the employees of the employer in the unit wish to have the applicant trade union represent them as their bargaining agent.

**AND WHEREAS** the parties are bound by a collective agreement entered into on September 12, 2005 and which expires on April 8, 2009.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that the Canadian Union of Postal Workers be, and it is hereby certified to be, the bargaining agent for a unit comprising:

"all messengers who are commissioned delivery persons, commissionaires, owners or lessees of their vehicle or their bicycle,

route drivers utilizing the company's vehicle or runners or all salaried staff carrying out duties related to the pick-up, transport and delivery of letters and small parcels, <u>excluding</u> managerial, administrative and dispatch personnel."
