The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a two-day public hearing on the application by TRIUMF Accelerators Inc., for the renewal of the operating licence for the TRIUMF particle accelerator facility. The facility is located on the University of British Columbia campus, in Vancouver, British Columbia.

TRIUMF Accelerators Inc. has applied for the renewal of its licence for a five-year period, until March 31, 2012.
