The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a two-day public hearing on an application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) for an amendment to their existing Waste Management Facility Operating Licence to authorize the construction of a proposed expansion to the storage component of the existing used fuel processing and storage facility located at the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) site in Pickering, Ontario.

Public hearings begin at 8:30 am and follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

CNSC staff received notice from OPG of its intent to apply for an amendment to their existing licence to authorize the construction of a proposed expansion to the storage component of the existing used fuel processing and storage facility at the Pickering NGS. Before the CNSC heard OPG's application, an environmental assessment was completed in compliance with the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act (CEAA). Following a public hearing held on April 28, 2004, the CNSC announced its conclusion that OPG's proposed expansion to the storage component of the existing used fuel processing and storage facility at the Pickering NGS, taking into account the appropriate mitigation measures, is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

The public is invited to participate in the hearing on the licence application either by oral presentation or written submission on Hearing Day Two.
