# *Revised Notice of Public Hearing*

A Notice of Public Hearing was published on December 7, 2005 to announce that the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is holding a two-day public hearing on an application by New Brunswick Power Nuclear Corporation (NB Power Nuclear), for the renewal of its licence to operate the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station. This revised Notice of Public Hearing provides information on the broadcast, via videoconference, of the Hearing Day Two.
