



Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a two-day public hearing on an application by New Brunswick Power Nuclear Corporation (NB Power Nuclear), for the renewal of its licence to operate the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station. The facility is located southwest of Saint John, New Brunswick, on the Lepreau Peninsula.

NB Power Nuclear has applied for a 5-year licence to allow for the operation and refurbishment of the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station.
